Burrendong Botanic Garden and Arboretum

Overlooking the majestic Lake Burrendong, explore over 164 hectares dedicated to the preservation and conservation of Australia's unique and incredibly diverse flora. With 2500 species of native plants, it is one of Australia's major botanic gardens. Fern Gully, a man-made 1km walk under rainforest ferns, is a highlight.

Discover the underground at Wellington Caves. Take a guided tour and be amazed by 15m tall crystal formations, intricate cave corals, 400-million-year-old fossils and 1 million-year-old megafauna fossils.

Formed over millions of years, the Cathedral Cave contains Wellington's famous stalagmite. This inspiring limestone structure reaches a staggering 15 metres in height.

Gaden Cave

The Gaden Cave is the smaller of the two show caves but contains large amounts of stalactites, cave coral, flowstone and helictites. There are 240 steps in the Gaden Cave and requires a reasonable level of fitness.

Phosphate/Fossil Mine - Temporarily Closed

The Phosphate Mine is a restored underground mine from a bygone era. Steeped in history and showcasing Megafauna bones from the Pleistocene period 1 million years ago. Hard hat is supplied and must be worn in the mine at all times.
