A HISTORY OF HOSTING SUCCESS AND A STRONG SUPPLY INDUSTRY

TOP 5

Our top 5 reasons why you should hold your live performance or music festival in the Dubbo Region.

1. CHOICE OF VENUES WITH A PROVEN RECORD

The Dubbo Showground is fully fenced and hosted 18,000 people at Triple J's One Night Stand music festival. Lazy River Estate has hosted three Red Hot Summer Tour music festivals attracting upwards of 5,000 people.

2. PLENTY OF ACCOMMODATION

Dubbo Region boasts bed-capacity in excess of 5,000; with a further 5,000 beds within a 2 hour radius.

3. CENTRALLY LOCATED AND EASILY ACCESSED

Dubbo is located in the heart of New South Wales and sits on the junction of three major highways. More than 200 flights connect the Dubbo Region to 9 destinations.

4. BURGEONING TARGET DEMOGRAPHIC

The Dubbo Region boasts a resident population of 52,000 and a catchment population in excess of 200,000 people. There are more than 180,000 people aged 20-49 years within a 4 hour radius.

5. A STRONG EVENT SUPPLY INDUSTRY AT YOUR FINGERTIPS

The Dubbo Region is supported by a robust supply chain to help you arrange and deliver your event.

EVENT VENUES WITH A PROVEN RECORD

Dubbo Showground has a wide range of venues with the capacity for more than 18,000 people in the main arena and an undercover area of 6,000 square metres. The Showground is fully fenced and includes a function centre perfectly appointed to accommodate back-of-house activities including 'green room' and media.

The Dubbo Showground attracted record crowds to Triple J's One Night Stand in 2013. The 60,000 square metre venue is located in the centre of Dubbo and is a short walk to no less than 30 motels.

Lazy River Estate is supported by an experienced events team with the expertise to assist in the development of event management plans and marketing and promotion of events.

Several large-scale music festivals have been held on the site which is located a short distance from residential areas. The national touring production, Red Hot Summer Tour, has held 3 successful events at the venue attracting upwards of 5,000 people.

PLENTY OF ACCOMMODATION

The Dubbo Region has a proven record of success when supporting large influxes of people. With over 5,000 beds on offer across the region, and access to a further 5,000 within a 2 hour radius, the Dubbo Region has the capacity to support large music festivals.

There is an abundance of group accommodation providing a wide range of options including self-contained units, family rooms, cabins and both powered and unpowered sites for those ready to bunk down with friends for the night.

CENTRALLY LOCATED AND EASILY ACCESSED

Dubbo is located in the heart of New South Wales and is easily accessed by road, rail and air.

The Newell, Mitchell and Golden highways converge in Dubbo and connect the region to each point of the compass.

Festival-goers can leave the car at home and travel by rail via NSW Trainlink's daily XPT service out of Sydney. The fast-paced train departs Central Station daily stopping at various stations along the Western route before returning to Sydney each day.

Headliners, musicians and staff can fly direct to and from 9 destinations including Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane and Newcastle. The **Dubbo City Regional Airport** is a 5 minute drive to Dubbo's CBD and is serviced by a large taxi fleet, including wheelchair accessible vehicles. There are also 4 hire car companies to assist with transfer needs.

As a service centre to a catchment population of more than 200,000 people, the Dubbo Region has access to a community that is passionate and at the ready for live music, aspiring artists and community celebrations.

Within a 4 hour drive your festival can tap into more than 82,000 people aged 18-35 years and over 100,000 people aged 35-50 years.

Dubbo is also home to a campus of Charles Sturt University and the City attracts a strong cohort of young people undertaking TAFE studies and apprenticeships.
