

ANIMALS ON BIKES EYE SPY FAMILY QUIZ

Start your tripometer on 000 as you turn off the Mitchell Highway from Molong onto Obley Road/Banjo Patterson Way. The following "paddock art" sculptures are in order from Molong-Cumnock- Yeoval-Dubbo;

1. Packwell (First in Australian Animal category) by John Packham & Stuart Caldwell
Description; Oversize copy of veteran motorcycle with 2 blue heeler dogs on board rounding up the cattle
Distance; 4.38km from Molong Mitchell highway (right hand side amongst trees)
Eye Spy; What animals can you see on and around this large sculpture?



2. Spikes on Spokes by the Marriott Family
Description; Spike family of echidnas en route to Banjo Paterson Way Ant Eating Festival
Materials; Saw blades, parts of T Robinson & Co Pty Ltd harvester (circa 1920) & random scrap metal
Distance: 8.12km from Molong (left hand side)
Eye Spy; How many echidnas on the bike?

3. Jump on Wheels by the Molong Men's Shed
Description; Kangaroo on a large pennyfarthing
Distance; 11.8km from Molong (left hand side)
Eye Spy; What is another name for a kangaroo?

4. Lizzy (2nd in Australian Animals and People's Choice Award) by Graeme Fleming & Mal Williams
Description; Lizzy the frillneck lizard with handbag and hat on a penny farthing bike
Materials; scrap material from a farm rubbish tip at Bourke NSW
Distance; 13.9km (right hand side)
Eye Spy; What colour is Lizzy's nailpolish?

5. Bit between the Teeth by Ivan Pine
Description; Horse with arm in the air riding a Go-cart
Distance; 15km (right side)
Eye Spy; Which direction is this sculpture facing?

6. Catch Me If You Can by Andy Kerr
Description; Wind positional corrugated iron and iron post kangaroo on a bush fire red postman's bike
Distance: 18.7km (left side)
Eye Spy; How does this sculpture spin around?

7. Rambo by Phillip King
Description; Mulsed Ram with horns and 2 blow-flies buzzing around behind
Materials; fencing wire, old cart wheels, auger head and parts from Cumnock backyard tip
Placement; 19.6km from Molong after "Tallowood" on Rosehill Lane corner (right side)
Eye Spy; How many blowflies are buzzing around this sheep?

8. Fizzy the Elephant by Christine Weston
Description; Bright pink baby elephant with sparkly crown reaching for little pink diamante bike
Distance: 20.3km and after "Golden Glen" gates (left side under trees)
Eye Spy; What is on the elephants back?

9. Cow Jumped Over the Moon by the Cumnock Playgroup
Description; Cow riding a bike and jumping over the moon
Distance: 21km from Molong (left)
Eye Spy; How is the cow going to reach the moon?

10. Ezyrider (2nd in Farmer category)by Don Bruce
Description; Giraffe riding a trike -corrugated iron cut individually, 1960s plough frame and wagon wheel parts
Placement; 21.5km from Molong and only 0.8km to Cumnock (right side)
Eye Spy; Which town is this giraffe looking at?

11. "K-T-Bird" Horse and Jockey by David Weston
Description; red, white and blue horse riding a scooter with jockey sitting behind encouraging him to go faster
Materials; 44 gallon drum, 20 litre chemical drums, 4wd shock absorbers, float valve, grader blade, horse drawn cycle mower, farm metal scraps
Placement; opposite Cumnock Royal Hotel (right)
Eye Spy; What colour is the jockeys hat?

Turn left at the Cumnock Royal Hotel down McLaughlan Street just 500m and stop at Cumnock Police Station (left side)

12. Hog on a Chopper by Mick Bates (First in Letterbox category)
Description; Pig riding a flash motorbike
Eye Spy; What is this pig wearing?

13. Next door at 19 McLaughlan St is the other 2 Little pigs riding a motorbike by Matty Bone
Description: 2 pigs, an owl and lizard on a motorbike
Eye Spy: What animal is sitting on the petrol tank?

Make a U-turn and drive back to Obley St, turn left at the pub

14. Sea Eagle lost in a paddock by Lou Spicer
Sea Eagle landing on large motorbike doing a mono –made from sheet metal, old wheels, bikes
Placement; opposite CWA building in centre of Cumnock town 150m from Cumnock Royal hotel (right)
Eye Spy; What rugby league team does he play for?

15. Spotty the Caterpillar (2nd in Group category) by Cumnock Village Preschool
Description; 4m long caterpillar sitting on fence riding 3 bikes with lots of gumboots. 500m from hotel before bridge on left
Eye Spy; How many RED gumboots is the caterpillar wearing?

16. "Zip along Zebra, the water's getting cold!" (First in Foreign Animal category) by the Hiller family
Description; Hippo on sulky pulled by a unicycle riding zebra – made from everything from the tip!
Placement; next door to Cumnock Thrifty link and General store near petrol bowser (right hand side)
Eye Spy; What is the hippo sitting in?

17. Flying Magpie by Gavin Smith
Description; Black and white tin Magpie riding black 20 bike on right side on the roof of takeaway cafe
Eye Spy; What is name of this takeaway café?

Start tripometer again on 000 from the Cumnock Cookies Cafe

18. Hogan's Hero by Mick Bates
Description; Emu on a unicycle camouflaged in the trees on left hand side (180m) at the gates of Hogan Transport
Eye Spy; What is the name of the Transport company this is located in?

19. Chicken Trike by Callie Saul
Description; white chickens perched on a red tricycle at 55 Obley St (right hand side) 250m from Cafe
Eye Spy; How many chickens can you see?

20. Go Dog Go by Andy Kerr
Description; Dog riding mail box bike with Australian flag flying at 66 Obley St Cumnock (left hand side) 250m
Eye Spy; What colour is the dog?

21. Uncontrollable Ram (Highly Commended Award)by Peter Medcalf – this is a temporary structure-not weather proof
Description; Sheep on a trike which is a remote controlled wheelchair at 65 Obley St (left) 350m
Eye Spy; What is the street off Obley road this is near?

22. Ladybird by Chloe MacCarthy
Description; Bright Fluro Lady bird on a unicycle at 85 Obley St (right and 580m from café)
Eye Spy; What colour is the ladybird's head?

23. Emu on a Penny farthing by Les Roberts
Description; Very fast pedaling bush chook
Placement; 850m and left side, after bridge and about 50m up the lane near Catholic church so tricky to see
Eye Spy; What is the name of the nearby creek?

24. Rainbow Serpent by Matt Mercer
Description; 4m long and high snake made out of old wooden verandah brackets sitting on wheel shell
Placement; 2.25m from café and left hand side after s-bend in road
Eye Spy: What is supporting this snake so does not fall over?

25. Excited Frog on a Bike by Rob and Alex Murray
Description; A very happy green frog having fun on a penny farthing
Distance; 4.6km from Cumnock café (left hand side)
Eye Spy; What colour are the frogs spots?

26. Orangutan on a Skate board by Roy Butler
Description; Orangutan eating while riding on blue skateboard made out of wood board
Placement; in paddock about 100m up in hills just after bridge (right hand side and 5.4km from café)
Eye Spy; What is the orangutan eating?

27. Tandem Snakes by Troy Vickers
Description; Blue tandem bike with two yellow cartoon snakes (male and female)
Placement; after gates of "Homewood" and 6.5km from Cumnock (left hand side)
Eye Spy; How many teeth can you see?

28. Elephants on Bikes by Darryl Hodges
Description; Mother elephant and baby following behind (left) 7.3km
Eye Spy; What letter can you see on the elephants?

29. Sheep thrills featuring Evil Ken Weevil! by James and Emily Hart
Description; Large bike made from scrap machinery parts with weevil attached to bike spoke and sheep on top.
Placement; 8.3km left side after "Yarrangrove" entrance
Eye Spy; What is the main difference between each side of the sheep?

30. Yullundry Roo (First in Farmer category) by Robert Armstrong
Description; Kangaroo on a Bike (left side) and just next to Yullundry woolshed. 10.3km.
Eye Spy; What is the approx height of this sculpture?

31. Scrappy Pig Junior by Robert Anderson
Description; Pig on trike made from recycled and new steel, placed on dam bank (right) 17.3km
Eye Spy; What different colour is this pig sculpture?

32. Fast Animals on Bikes (First in Group category) by Wellington Men's Shed
Description; 5 sculptures of Australian and zoo animals made from corrugated iron, scrap metal and old bikes
Placement; (left) 20.7km from Cumnock
Eye Spy; What are the 5 animals in this group?

33. Duckcycle by James Blatch
Description; Duck on bike made from a Bag loader and Sunshine Harvester parts
Placement; (right side) 21 km and brown so tricky to see
Eye Spy; How far is this sculpture from the road?

34. "Rough riding" by Matthew Phillipson
Description; Man stuck in back of cow after falling off bicycle
Distance: 23km from Cumnock and only 1km out of Yeoval (right side)
Eye Spy; Why did the man fall off his bike?

35. "Emu on a unicycle" by Jason Guise
Description; Emu riding on a unicycle across the road from Rough riding (left side) 23 km on rocky hill
Eye Spy; What is the emu wearing on his feet?

36. "Mother and Son" by Jeff Tanner
Description; kangaroo and joey on penny farthing behind the Emu on a unicycle (left side) 23km
Eye Spy; What flag is flying behind this bike?

Yeoval –turn right for coffee or snack stop–Billabong Café, and Gift and Hardware store. Stop tripometer and start again from Yeoval Royal Hotel when you continue your journey along Obley Road

37. Ram on the Rocks by Karen Neale
Description; Ram on a bike on rocks just after Yeoval (right side) 800m
Eye Spy: How many horns does this ram have?

38. Rex rider (2nd in Australian Animal category) by Neville Smith
Description; Dinosaur skeleton with sharp teeth riding penny farthing, made from Tyre, metal, header wheel
Placement; (left) 1km after Yeoval and 64.6 from Newell highway at Dubbo
Eye Spy; What colour is the dinosaur's tongue?

39. Flash Ralph by Bob Hansford
Description Emu on a bike made from chain, cog, recycled machinery parts
Placement; 11km from Yeoval and near Obley turn off (left hand side)
Eye Spy; Is this sculpture painted?

40. Pigs Might Fly by Lyn Press
Description; Pink pig with wings on treadmill bike
Placement; 11km from Yeoval on right hand side near Obley turn off
Eye spy; What sort of bike is the pig riding?

41. Spider on Bike by Murray Ward
Description Black spider on bike
Placement; "Hampton" letterbox (right hand side) 15km
Eye Spy: How many legs does a spider have?

42. Bug on a Bike by Anna McIntyre
Description; Small Dragon fly made of Steel, wire and bubble wrap
Placement; 200R Obley rd Toongi (left side) 45km
Eye Spy; What is the mailbox?

43. Going Home by Robert Miller
Description A Black cow with her calf in tow heading home from the long paddock.
Placement; "Allambie Stud" 197 Obley st Dubbo (left hand side) 45km
Eye Spy question; What are the numbers on the ear tags?

44. Pelicycle by Rowena Galway +Latex bedding team
Description: A tricky Australian Pelican showing off his balancing techniques on a unicycle.
Placement: Dundullimal homestead entrance (right hand side approaching Dubbo)
Distance ; 64km from Yeoval and 1km to Newell highway
Eye Spy question; What material is the pelican made from?
