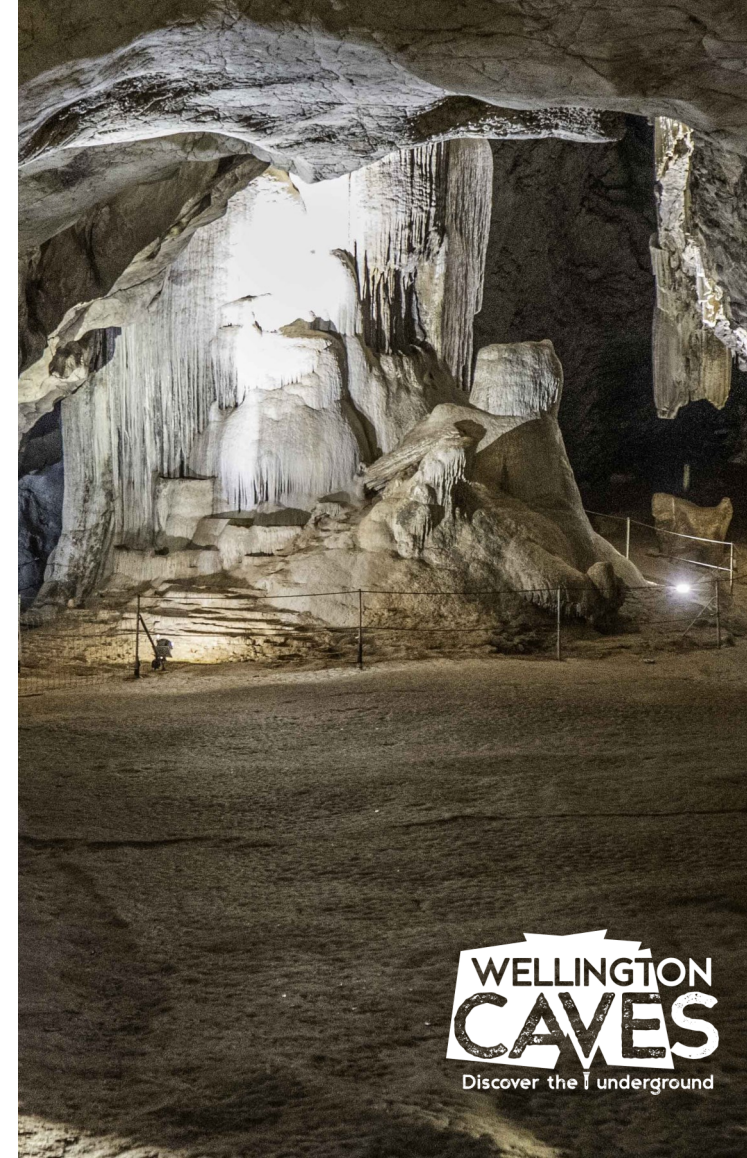

CATHEDRAL CAVE TOUR

The Cathedral Cave is the largest and most popular of the show caves. Highlights of this tour include the Altar (a 15m tall crystal formation), The Well and the site of a fossil dig conducted by Flinders University. Hard hats (provided or BYO) and enclosed shoes are required.

GADEN CAVE TOUR

Gaden is the smallest of the show caves but it is full of intricate and delicate crystal formations including spa crystals and cave coral. Hard hats (provided or BYO) and enclosed shoes required.

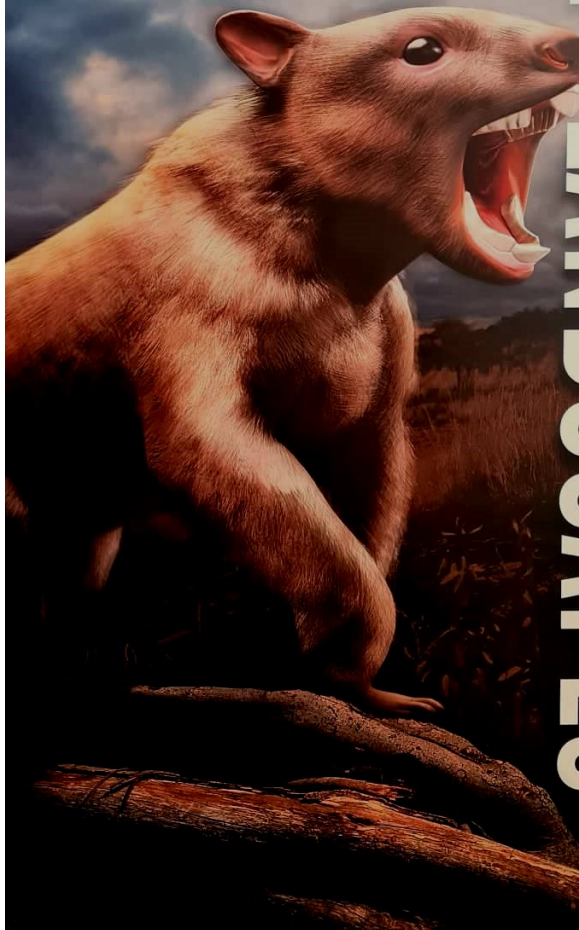

DISCOVERY LAB

Become a palaeontologist for the day. Discover the history of Australian Megafauna and it's significance at Wellington Caves. Learn about fascinating creatures such as Diprotodon, the largest marsupial ever to roam Australia, Thylacoleo, a fierce marsupial predator and Genyornis, who has the nickname of Demon Duck of Doom.

Dig through million year old sediment extracted from our Phosphate Mine and see what bones, fossils and other cave treasures you can discover!
